





Université Toulouse III (UT3) Campus Experience participants will have the opportunity to discover one of the biggest universities in France by visiting several of its most noteworthy infrastructures. With links to research, student training and campus life, these visits will give participants an insight into the important role played by the university in the economic and scientific development of the Occitanie region.

The Campus Experience will start with a warm welcome from the UT3 President, followed by a presentation of the most important features and key figures of the institution. Then, participants will have the opportunity to visit various facilities located in the UT3 campus, including the library or the Catalyseur, a co-working space aiming to develop student business projects.

The tour will be followed by a lunch on a terrace in a restaurant located on the campus. In the afternoon, participants can attend workshops about international relations. Then some of UT3's highly strategic infrastructures will be visited in small groups, including the Oncopole, a cancer research centre, and the MFJA, a training, research and innovation centre dedicated to mechanical, manufacturing and aeronautics engineering.

Université Toulouse III– Paul Sabatier (UT3) is one of the biggest universities in France. It offers a wide range of courses in Science, Health, Sport, Technology and Engineering and employs more than 4500 academic and administrative staff members.
